Listen to Me Resources

Purpose Using this 'All About Me' resource is a way of adults finding out information from the child regarding their strengths, likes, aspirations, relationships with adults or peers and areas they wish to make improvements within. It is a particularly useful activity to complete with children/young people as part of the transition process. Listen to Me Questionnaire to build a profile of the pupil.

Resources

- Sentence starters or questions provided below presented in any format matching the pupil's needs.
- Any art or craft materials you wish to turn the activity into a creative project.

Instructions for use:

The sentence starters or questions provided below could be presented to the pupil on post it notes, and the pupil could write a paragraph about themselves. Or, these prompts could be used within a writing frame format for the pupil to complete or an adult could scribe their responses. An electronic version could also be created for the pupil to complete using a laptop. Text to speech software could also be used so that the sentence prompts are read out to the child without needing the support of an adult. This activity could be combined with the pupil creating a model, picture, or portrait – be creative as you like!

Adapt the questions to suit your pupil and be curious.

The information gained from completing this activity would be used to inform specific outcomes or provision to put into place based on the child's strengths, aspirations, and goals within the process of the graduated approach.
